Order

1. If the Respondent fails to return the Children to the Applicant within seven days from the date of being notified of this decision, the Respondent is ordered to pay the Applicant the amount of money calculated at the rate of 500,000 KRW per day, from the day following

the expiration of the period above to the day on which the implementation is completed.

2. The remaining applications of the Applicant are dismissed.
3. Each person shall bear the application fee.

Purpose of Application

The Respondent shall pay 1,000,000 KRW per day to the Applicant, from the date of being notified of this decision, until the return of the Children.

Reason

Regarding the Judgment and details stated in the Request for the Child Return Trial and considering the progress of the Execution Order and Detention Order prescribed by the Civil Execution Act & the Hague International Child Abduction Convention (Respondent refusing to comply with the Detention Order by disappearing and hiding with the young children), to return the children, it is necessary to order the Indirect Enforcement to the Respondent. Furthermore, if the Respondent fails to return the Children, taking into consideration the damage it'll cause to the Applicant and the welfare of the Children, the amount of the Indirect Enforcement shall be set at 500,000 won per day until the Respondent returns the Children. If so, the application, in this case, is decided as an order to cite it for reasons within the scope of the recognition above and to dismiss the remaining application without cause.
